



Rick Weidinger, Chairman, and Chief Executive Officer of Robotic VISION Technologies Inc. [RVT]

Mr. Weidinger is the Founder and majority owner of RVT. Previous to his management and investment in RVT, Mr. Weidinger created a legacy of innovation and technology success stories, serving as a chief architect behind the emergence and growth of such highly regarded fiber-optic telecommunications organizations as the Institutional Communications Company, MFS Communications Company (MFS) and Pontio Communications. At Pontio, he was Chairman, CEO and majority shareholder of the local fiber-optic company, which he sold to a Fortune 50 company in 2001.

Prior to Pontio, Mr. Weidinger served as a founding member and Vice President of Corporate Development for MFS, where he was responsible for over twenty-five transactions representing over \$25 billion dollars including the acquisition of UUNET in 1994 and the sale of MFS in 1996.

Mr. Weidinger has been owner and co-owner of Indy 500 cars from 2004 to 2007 as well as the owner of A1 Team USA representing the United States of America in the Open-Wheel Formula Series A1 Grand Prix World Cup of Motorsports from 2005 to 2008. Mr. Weidinger holds both Juris Doctor and MBA degrees from Creighton University and a Bachelor of Science degree in Finance from the University of Nebraska.
